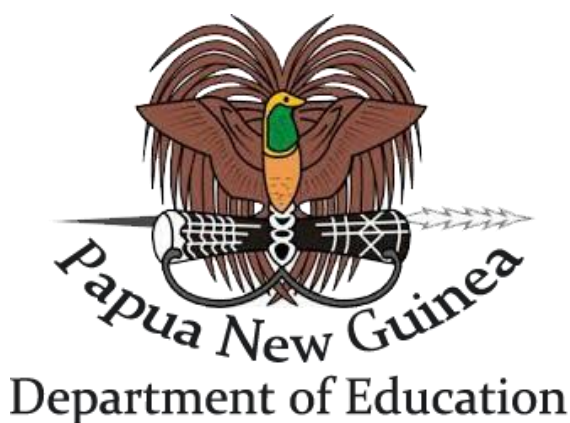


# Year 7 & 8.

All students follow a general course consisting of:

The PNG Department of Education administers the Certificate of Basic Education, COBE.

All Grade 8 PNG citizens are tested in a range of subjects to ensure that they are reaching National achievement goals.

The testing occurs in October every year.

Students sit three examinations; English, Mathematics and Combined Subjects.

Parents have the option of also selecting the Cambridge International Assessment Course for examination in Year 8.

Cambridge Checkpoint tests have been designed to assess learning at the end of Cambridge Secondary 1. They are available in English, Mathematics and Science, and give valuable feedback on learners' strengths and weaknesses before they progress to the next stage of education.

The tests are marked in Cambridge and provide schools with an external international benchmark for learner performance. Each learner receives a statement of achievement and a diagnostic feedback report, giving schools detailed information and parents extra trust in the feedback they receive.

We hold Cambridge Checkpoint test series each year in October. The tests cover all major areas of learning in the Cambridge Secondary 1 curriculum frameworks for English, Mathematics and Science.
