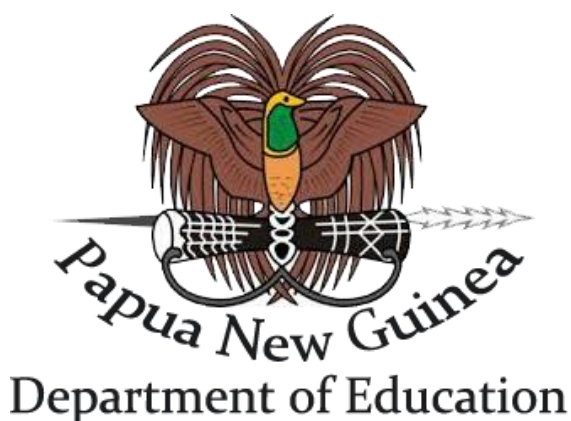


Years 9 & 10.

The PNG Department of Education administers the Lower Secondary School Certificate, LSSC.

Students who wish to graduate with a Lower Secondary School Certificate must take English, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Personal Development and at least two of the following subjects: Business Studies, Music, Art & Design, Design & Technology, Family & Consumer Studies, Information Technology or Computer Applications.
