Understanding Bullying

What is Bullying?



Bullying is when someone keeps doing or saying things to have power over another person



Bullying is wrong behaviour which makes the person being bullied feel afraid or uncomfortable

Some people think that bullying is part of growing up and a way for young people to learn to stick up for themselves. But bullying can make young people feel lonely, unhappy and frightened. It makes them feel unsafe and think there must be something wrong with them. They lose confidence and may not want to go to school any more. It makes them sick

What to Do

Try ignoring the bully, tell them to stop and walk away whenever the bullying starts.



If someone is bullying you, you should always tell an adult you can trust. This isn't telling tales. You have a right to be safe and adults can do things to get the bullying stopped.

If you find it difficult to talk about being bullied, you might find it easier to write down what's been happening to you and give it to an adult you trust.
